

What's the saying—"You learn something new every day?" I learned something new just this week that might be of interest to some. The VA does actually have a dental insurance program. It's called VA Dental Insurance Program (VADIP). For qualified Veterans, it offers discounted private dental insurance for the veteran and family members.

To be eligible one of these qualifiers must be true:

- ♦ A Veteran who is currently enrolled in VA healthcare, or
- The current or surviving spouse or dependent child of a Veteran or service member, and you are enrolled in CHAMPVA.

VADIP provides coverage throughout the United States and its territories. VADIP helps the Veteran purchase private dental insurance at a reduced cost. If you are a Veteran that happens to have free VA dental care, enrollment through VADIP does not affect your free VA dental care. The VADIP plans cover many common dental procedures such as preventative dental care, dental surgery, and even emergency dental care. The costs depend on which carrier you choose and which plan. The current carriers are MetLife Dental and Delta Dental, each offering different plans. The VADIP program currently is in effect by law until December 31, 2021. 


