NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Section 7-255 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, that the Thomaston Water Pollution Control Authority (WPCA) will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, October 15, 2019 at 7:00PM at the Thomaston Water Pollution Control Facility located at 258 Old Waterbury Road, Thomaston, CT. 06787. At this time property owners shall have the opportunity to be heard concerning proposed changes in the charges for use of the sewerage system.

The proposed increase in the user charge is due to the increased cost of operation and maintenance of our Water Pollution Control Facility and is a requirement of Section 204 of the Federal Pollution Control Act amendments of 1972, Public Law 92-500 and the Clean Water Act of 1977, Public Law 95-217.

Copies of the proposed charges are available to the public in the Town Clerk's office in the Thomaston Town Hall, 158 Main Street, Thomaston, CT. 06787.

The proposed rate increase is as follows:

1. The current rate is \$ 7.37 per thousand gallons and the proposed rate is \$7.45 per thousand gallons.
2. The current residential rate is \$368.50 per unit per year and the proposed is \$ 372.50 per unit per year.
3. Commercial and Industrial users will pay for actual gallons used at the proposed rate. Current minimum rate is \$368.50 and the new proposed annual minimum rate is \$372.50. Same minimum rate as residential.
4. Municipal users will pay for actual gallons used at the proposed rate.
