

ABSENTEE BALLOTS BECOME AVAILABLE JULY 21, 2020 FOR DEMOCRATIC AND REPUBLICAN PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARIES AUGUST 11, 2020



The Secretary of the State is mailing absentee ballot applications to all registered voters eligible to vote in the August 11, 2020 primaries. Ballots become available on Tuesday, July 21, 2020.

Absentee Ballots are available for electors registered to either the Democratic or Republican party who will not be able to vote in person at the polls on August 11, 2020 due to active service in the Armed Forces, absence from town during all the hours of voting, illness, physical disability, or religious tenets. Governor Lamont's Executive Order 7QQ permits any voter to use COVID-19 as a valid reason for requesting an absentee ballot for the Primary. If you did not receive an application or have misplaced it, an Absentee Ballot Application form may be printed from this site or obtained from the Town Clerk's office either in person or through the mail. Completed applications must be returned to the Town Clerk's office of the town where the applicant is an elector. Ballots must be given or mailed directly to the applicant; they may not be given to another person for delivery to the applicant. Voters can check their party and registration status at: <http://myvote.ct.gov/lookup>. The deadline for changing party enrollment to vote in the primary has passed. However, unregistered voters may enroll online at <https://voterregistration.ct.gov/OLVR/welcome.do>, by mail or in person with the Registrars of Voters or Town Clerk.
