

CERTIFICATE OF TRADE NAME

NOTE: Required by section 35-1 of the Connecticut General Statutes, a trade name certificate is for the purpose of identifying those doing business in the state under a fictitious trade name, i.e. for consumer protection purposes. A trade name certificate does not protect that name from use by someone else. A trade name may be protected from use by others by registering it with the Secretary of State, 30 Trinity Street, Hartford, Ct. 06106. The penalty for failure to file a trade name certificate is \$500.00.
