**1. Call to Order**

D. Colavecchio called the meeting to order at 8:15pm immediately following the referendum on the Town budget. D. Colavecchio announced that the proposed 2010-2011 Town Budget was defeated; the votes were 839-No and 636-Yes.

**2. Budget Discussion**

G Seabourne recommended that the First Selectman approach the Town department heads and unions and ask them if they would make concessions prior to the Board of Finance making any cuts to the budget. Selectman Mone said he would make the request.

The Board determined that the budget increase should not exceed 2.7% which would require a cut of \$347,834.

E.Mone will identify cuts in the amount of \$173,917 which is half of the proposed cut; the other half will come from the Education budget.

The meeting scheduled for Tuesday May 4, 2010 was cancelled.

On a motion by G. Seabourne, seconded by K. M. O'Sullivan, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30pm.
