



The Hillside Cemetery Association Committee met on Friday, August 13, 2010 at 5:00pm in their Town Hall office.

Chris opened the meeting with his report on the Bank Stabilization Proposal.. He has been working with the Inland Wetlands Commission to correct the problem. The Commission has accepted the proposal Submitted by Milone and Mac Broom at a cost of \$4,752.50. Jamie will be working with Paul Pronovost on the best way to get this plan implemented

In his Sexton's report Jamie stated that he has checked all our equipment. Some items are too rusty or used to be of any use to us. He will check with other Town Departments to see if these items could be of use to them. He pointed out that there is a large Hemlock tree on the North Hill that should come down. He also recommended that the employees should receive a wage increase .The Committee agreed with his recommendation . Chris made a motion to raise each salary by .50 per hour making the wage scale \$8.50, \$9.00 and \$10.00 per hour. Dave seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Jamie also spoke about the importance of placing the Cemetery records on the computer.
