Jamie Wilson showed us a geo survey of the cemetery property which was interesting.

Julie Ingham will be in touch with Bea Fuller for advice on where annual flowers should be planted before Memorial Day. A local Girl Scout Troop will assist Julie with the planting.

We need two new gas powered trimmers so Jamie will get prices for the next meeting.

Julie Ingham made a motion to adjourn which was seconded by Kris Nelson at 6:53 P.M.
