Subject: Cemetery Comission Meeting Minutes 08/25/15

The Cemetery Committee meeting was called to order by Chairman Kris Nelson at 6:05 p/m on 08/25/15, at the Cemetery Office, Level 4, Thomaston Town Hall.

Present: Members, Kris Nelson, Tom Scully, Troy Fields and Cemetery Sexton Jamie Wilson.

A motion was made by Kris Nelson and seconded by Tom Scully to approve the minutes from the July 21, 2015 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Members reviewed the bill from Greenwood Masonry Construction for work completed at the Williams Chapel. A motion was made to accept and pay this bill by Kris Nelson and the motion was seconded by Tom Scully. Motion passed unanimously.

The land appraisal of the Toffolon property was discussed. Members decided to do a walk through of the property in the near future, to inspect the property and view it's potential.

The Ordinance Revision is going before a Town Meeting to be held on 08/26/15. Cemetery Sexton Jamie Wilson will be attending this meeting along with member Tom Scully, in the event that there are any questions concerning this revision.

The gate at the bottom of Dug Road has been installed by Cemetery Sexton Jamie Wilson. The gate will be secured when the two landowners are supplied with keys. Members will need to review and decide on the style of the gate at the cemetery entrance, before the two pillars can be installed.

Tom Scully is looking into the repair of the Williams Chapel windows with Jim Stevens and will get a quote for repair, rather than total replacement of the windows, due to the high cost to do so.

Cemetery Sexton Jamie Wilson received an estimate of \$2,800.00 from Gagnon Lawn Care Service to remove six large trees. A motion was made by Kris Nelson to hire Gagnon to perform this work and the motion was seconded by Tom Scully. Motion passed unanimously.

Cemetery Sexton Jamie Wilson stated that he received a request from a party concerning the construction of a stone mausoleum in the cemetery. It was determined that members would need more information from the party concerning this request.

Meeting adjourned at 6:55 p/m.
