A special meeting of the Thomaston Recreation Commission was held on Monday, July 19th. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Pam Deziel, at 7:36 P.M.

Roll Call:

Members present were Gary Wilson, Marty Stammer, Matt Stancavage, Rick Markey, Sean Czellecz, and Chairperson Pam Deziel. Also present was Marty Egan and 1st Selectman, Ed Mone.

Minutes:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the members. Marty Stammer made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Rick Markey seconded the motion. With all in favor, the minutes were accepted as read.

New Business:

- A. Nystrom's Legal Notice

The First Selectman, Ed Mone, addressed the Recreation Commission members regarding a legal notice that the Board of Selectman planned to publish in the newspaper to better give people who are attending the park a better understanding of the rules of the park regarding closing time and ultimately the closing of the gates at Nystrom's by the Thomaston Police Department each night.

Mr. Mone distributed a copy of the proposed notice to the members and it was reviewed by Commission members. Commission members were satisfied with the wording regarding the beach area but were worried athletic groups such as Little League and Thomaston Youth Soccer would not have concluded their activities to comply with the closing time of all activities at the park by 8:00 p.m. Commission members asked Marty Egan to contact those groups to better ascertain what would be an appropriate closing time during different time periods of the year so as not to hinder the completion of their events.

- B. Recreation Programs Sub-Committee

Commission members discussed putting together a series of questions that would be disseminated to various other municipalities and specifically their respective Park and Recreation Departments to better acquire information on how their programs work as it relates to their relationship with their Town Government and Finance Division or Office.

After discussion, members compiled a list of relevant questions and asked Marty Egan to format the questions along with a cover letter to be reviewed by the Commission members at the next Recreation Commission meeting to be held on Monday, August 9th.

Adjournment:

Sean Czellecz made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 P.M. Rick Markey seconded the motion. With all in favor, the meeting was adjourned.
